Commune: Kientzheim.

Owners: Blanck family.

Surface Area under Vine: 31 ha including Grands Crus Schlossberg, Furstentum and Mamburg.

Since the outgoing Philippe Blanck (in the vineyard) and his more reserved cousin Frédéric (who is responsible for the wines) took over from their parents in the early 1990s yields have been reduced and the winemaking cleaned up. The result is greater finesse and greater definition. This once humdrum property has now become one of Alsace's stars. The pick of the bunch are the mineral Schlossberg and Furstentum Rieslings; but in fact the whole range is now exemplary.
